Would you rather?

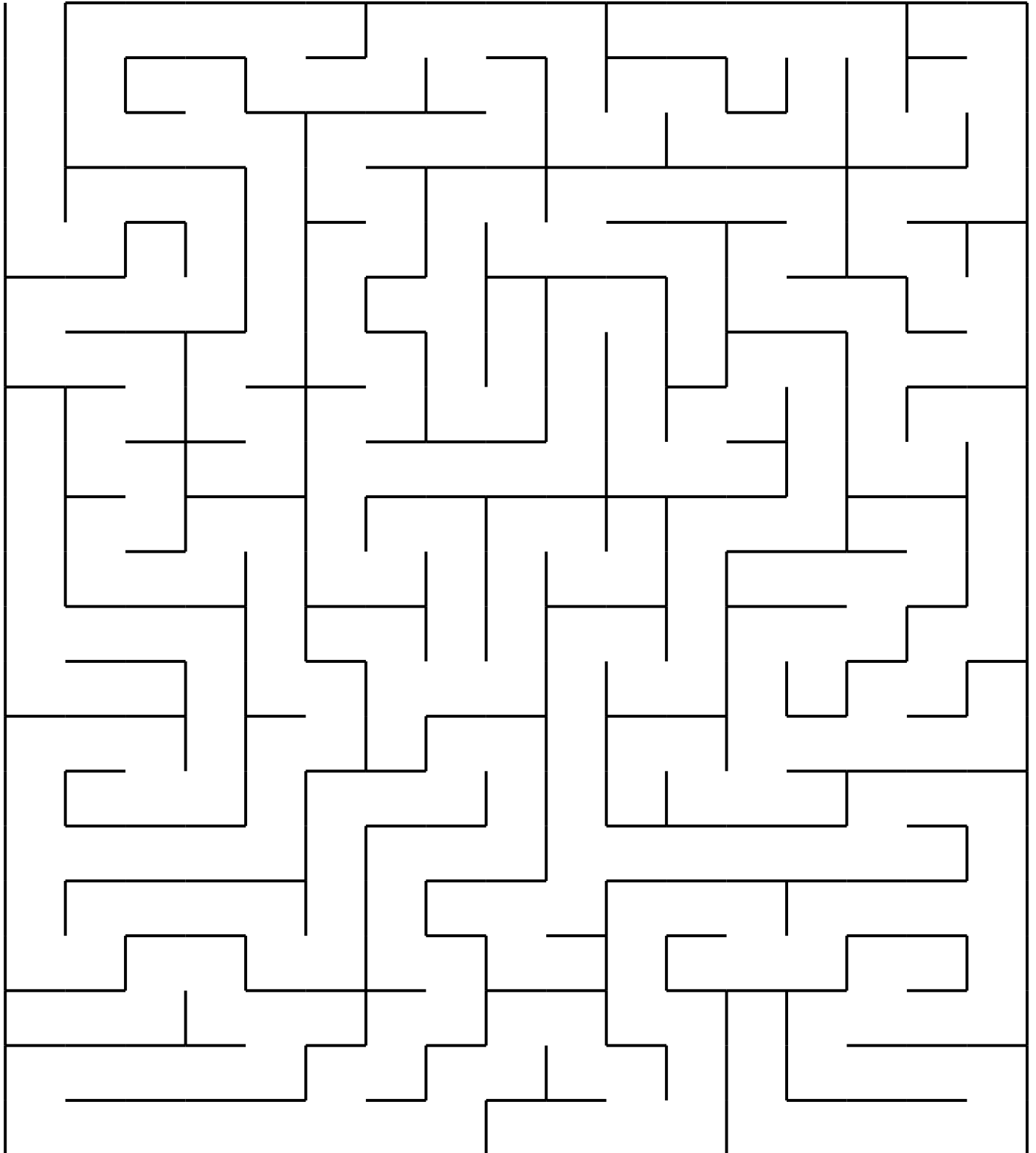
Read one out. Everybody answers, including the grown-ups.

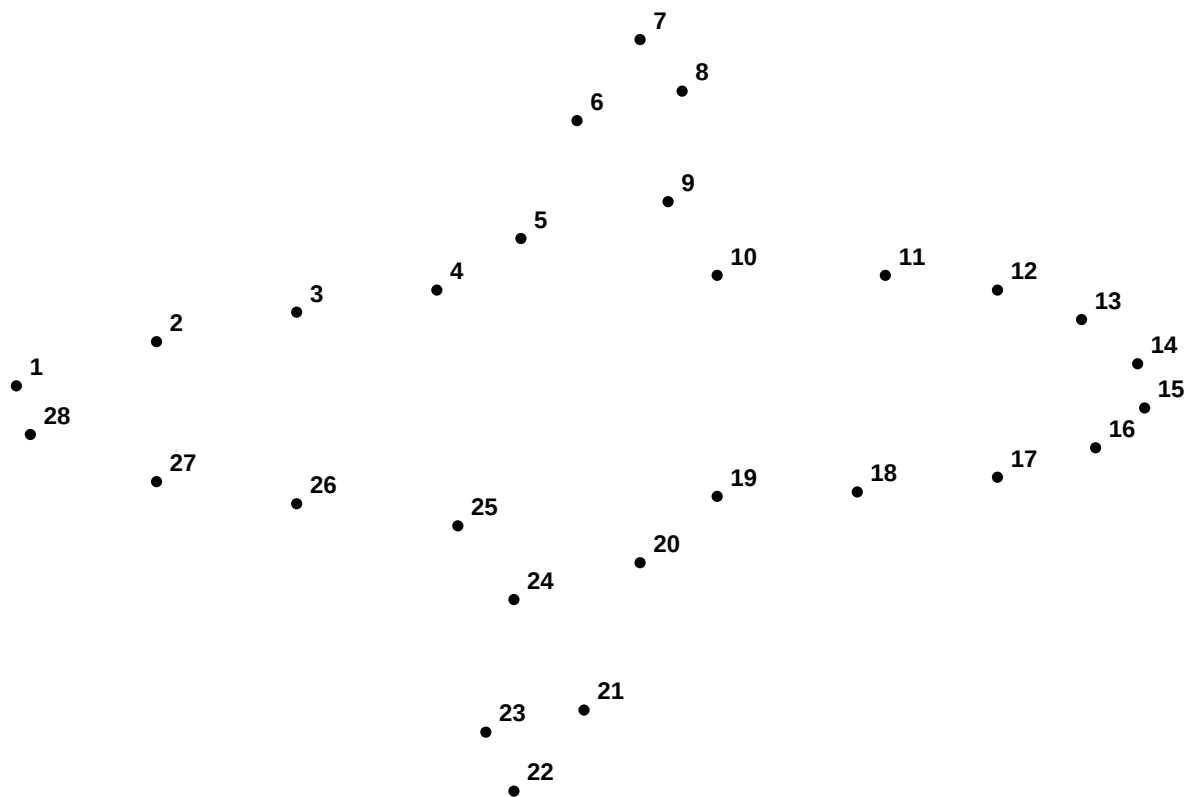

Word search solutions. Grown-ups only.

Airport word search — the fifteen words are: PILOT, RUNWAY, SUITCASE, WINDOW, CLOUD, TICKET, SEATBELT, TAKEOFF, LANDING, LUGGAGE, GATE, TRAY, WING, ENGINE, PASSPORT. They run across, down and diagonally, and some are written backwards.

The maze has exactly one route from START to SEAT 14A. If your kid gets stuck, tell them to work backwards from the seat — it is much easier and it is a genuinely useful thing to learn.
