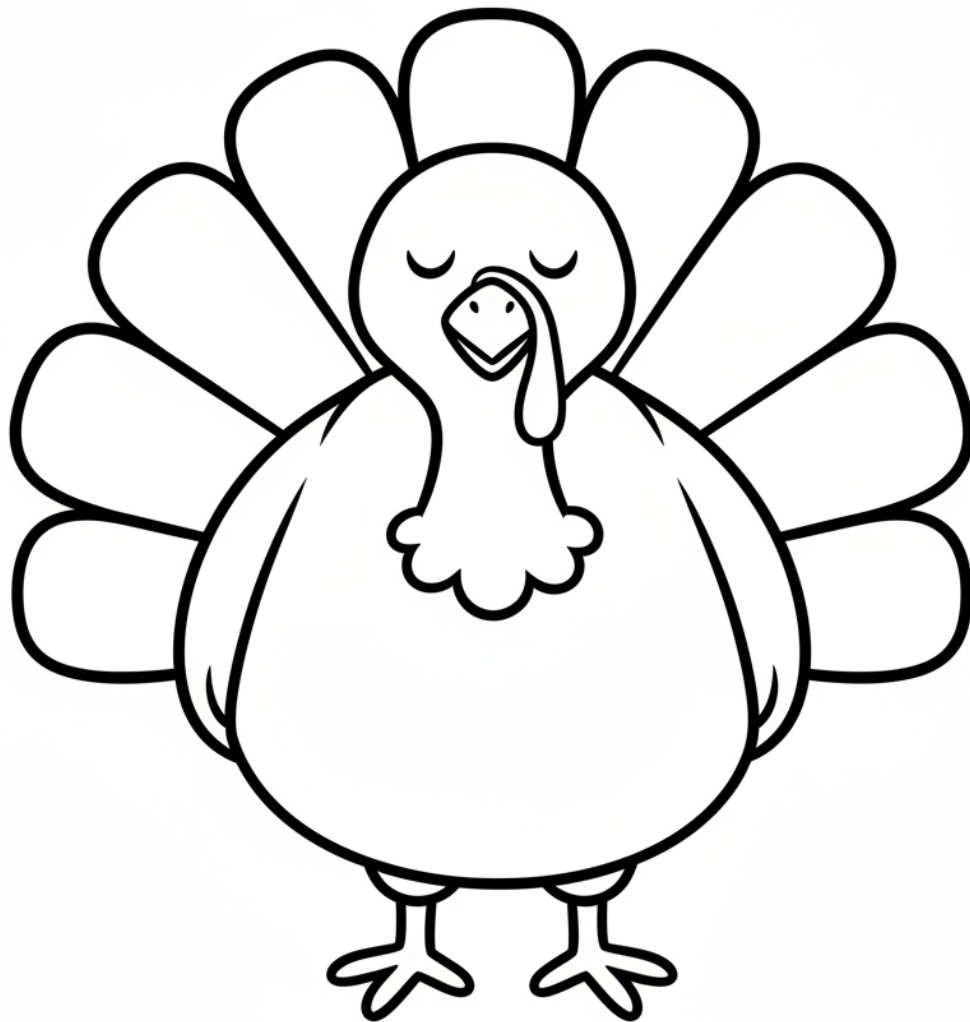
Disguise a Turkey Templates

Help this turkey hide so it can't be eaten for Thanksgiving.

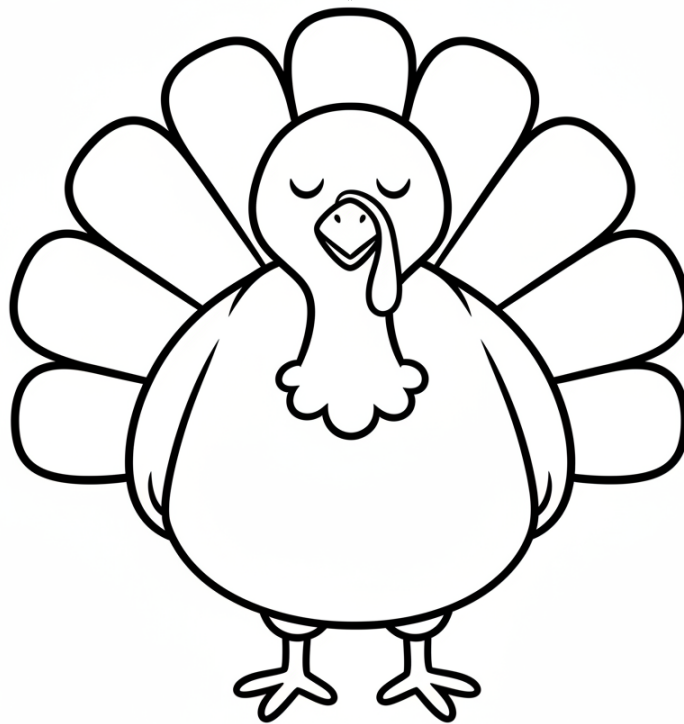


What is this turkey pretending to be?

Notes for teachers and parents

Disguise-a-Turkey is a Thanksgiving tradition. Kids are asked to disguise the turkey so it won't be eaten for the holiday. Costumes get inventive: astronauts, pirates, dragons, taco trucks, fairies, robots. The kid then explains the disguise in writing or out loud.

How to use these templates:

- Template A – full-page turkey for kindergarten and early first grade. Costume only.
- Template B – adds a speech bubble fill-in. Best for first and second grade.
- Template C – adds a writing prompt frame for third grade and up.

Quick scoring rubric (out of 4):

1. Costume hides the turkey (creativity).
2. Costume is fully drawn or colored in (completeness).
3. Written explanation matches the costume (coherence).
4. Bonus point for making the teacher laugh.
